WisCOSH invites you to join us as we mourn those men, women and teen workers killed on the job in 2012.

Join **WisCOSH** as we gather with workers to commemorate those mothers and fathers, brothers and sisters, sons and daughters, neighbors, friends and coworkers that have left us prematurely due to workplace injury or from illness caused by exposure at work.

**WisCOSH** will hold an informational discussion on the state of Wisconsin's workforce in both the public and private sector. Discussion will focus on current legislation at the State and Federal levels that will, and is, having a direct effect on worker's health and safety on the job. Including current and proposed legislation around "right to work" and the elimination of worker protecting regulations and the long overdue promulgation of new Standards.

Representative Gwen Moore, Senator Tammy Baldwin, Herb Kohl, Mayor Barrett and Milwaukee County D.A. John Chisholm are among those invited to speak.

**WisCOSH** will have a fundraiser dinner starting at 11:30am and lasting until 1pm. Profits from the meal go towards upkeep and maintenance of **Zeidler Union Square Park** and funding **WisCOSH** outreach and training activities.

Afterward **WisCOSH** will lead a candle light procession to **Zeidler Union Square Park** [Michigan Ave. between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> St. behind the Grand Avenue Mall] where a commemorative ceremony will be held including the reading of the names of Wisconsin's workers and military killed on the job during 2012.
